RULES FOR AWARD OF KURUKSHETRA UNIVERSITY GOLDEN JUBILEE SCHOLARSHIP

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The award of Scholarship known as **"Kurukshetra University Golden Jubilee Post Graduate Scholarships"** to be awarded to Below Poverty Line (BPL) /poor/needy & deserving students of University Teaching Departments/Institutes only having at least Second Division at the Graduation Level and family income not above Rs.6.00 lac per annum, out of the interest accruing from the Golden Jubilee Scholarship Corpus Fund. The guidelines for the award of **"Kurukshetra University Golden Jubilee Post Graduate Scholarships" for the session 2023-24** are as under:-

- The value of each scholarship shall be Rs.5000/- p.a. and the scholarships will be awarded to 90 students of Post Graduate Courses of University Teaching Departments/Institutes i.e. 45 scholarships for 1st year students and 45 scholarships for renewal of 2nd year students who were awarded in the 1st year. In the case of 3-year PG courses, the scholarship would be admissible only for the first two years.
- 2. The students studying in Post-Graduate Courses under self Financing Scheme in the University Teaching Departments/Institutes will not be entitled for this scholarship.
- 3. The Scholarship will be awarded in two installments subject to quarterly satisfactory progress report of the student availing the scholarship to be submitted by the concerned Chairperson/ Director.
- 4. The students availing any other scholarship/stipend/financial aid, etc. from any other source will not be entitled for this scholarship.
- 5. In case an awardee surrenders this scholarship due to one reason or the other, the scholarship will be awarded automatically for the remaining period to the next student on the waiting list.
- 6. In case, any awardee of this scholarship subsequently gets any other scholarship/stipend/financial aid, etc. from any other source, he/she will surrender this scholarship and refund the amount of the scholarship received by him/her, if any.
- 7. The scholarships are renewable for 2nd year subject to the conditions of passing 1st year examination **without re-appear** and submission of a certificate of good conduct by the student from the Chairperson/Director of the Department/Institute concerned.
- 8. Any change in the number and amount of the scholarships may be made by the Vice-Chancellor subject to the availability of funds.

9. Selection Procedure:

The Chairperson/Director of the concerned Department/Institute in **consultation with the Staff Council will recommend the names of three candidates** by taking into consideration the following to the Standing Selection Committee to be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor for final selection:

- (a) Percentage in lower examinations.
- (b) Matriculation passed from rural/urban area.
- (c) BPL card holder.
- (d) Family income not exceeding 6.00 Lac yearly.
- (e) Number of dependents.
- (f) Fatherless/Motherless students.
- 10. In addition to merit at the graduation level, special weightages of 5 marks each for the following shall be given subject to a maximum of 10 marks.
 - a) Fatherless/Motherless students
 - b) BPL card holders.
 - c) Students passing Matriculation from rural area.
